AGMK nurtures and promotes the creative arts in Milton Keynes. We provide workspaces to artists, makers and performers; networking events; workshops; and spaces to exhibit, perform and celebrate work. Our mission is to create a creatively dynamic city that embraces artists and is seen by the public as a place for artistic play.

AGMK is an organisation with several discrete elements operating more and less under its aegis. It includes:

- AGMK itself - the main arts development organisation
- Arts Central - the brand name under which AGMK rents out artists' studios
- MK LitFest - the annual literary festival, a project in which AGMK is the project manager and leads a partnership of others.

We also house the Community Arts Resource Centre (CARC) which operates the equipment hire business through its rented studio at Burners Lane. CARC is separate from AGMK - it was incorporated as a CIC limited by guarantee in 2009 - but is closely associated with us.

AGMK operates as a company limited by guarantee with charitable status and was incorporated in May 2008 and registered with the Charity Commission at the same time.

We are now looking to recruit several additional trustees to our board, to bring skills, knowledge and connections where we need them, and to bring further innovation and fresh thinking to the team who have helped it prosper so far.

Trustees provide the oversight and governance for the charity which includes a 60-artists studio complex; part-time staff team; grants from MK Community Foundation, MK Council and Arts Council England.

AGMK delivers social, cultural, educational and economic benefits for Milton Keynes and the central England area, bringing together artists of all kinds within a charitable and not-for-profit framework, providing a supportive,

challenging and inspirational programme of support and creative development.

Over the past 8 months we have undertaken an organisational development programme and adopted a new fundraising strategy which we are now ready to implement.

Following our recent skills audit, we are particularly looking for people who can help AGMK with some specific skills and knowledge:

- Digital media production and distribution industries
- Links with creative technology companies
- Education, social inclusion, equality and diversity
- Business Development & Fundraising

We are also looking for someone to lead the team overseeing MK LitFest.

We would like the board to have a wider representation of the diversity of our city, and a somewhat younger age profile.

The board holds monthly meetings and trustees take part in task-and-finish working groups when specific issues arise that need more intensive consideration.
