ARTS GATEWAY MK IS RECRUITING TRUSTEES

About Us

AGMK nurtures and promotes the creative arts in Milton Keynes. In our premises in the west side of Milton Keynes, we provide over 70 workspaces to artists, makers and performers. We have just completed the construction of a new accessible public space which will be used to exhibit, perform, educate and celebrate creative work.

Our organisation has several discrete elements operating more and less under its aegis:

- AGMK itself – the main arts development organisation
- Arts Central – the brand name under which AGMK rents out artists' studios
- MK LitFest – the annual literary festival, a project in which AGMK is the project manager and leads a partnership of others.

We also house the Community Arts Resource Centre (CARC) which operates the equipment hire business through its rented studio at Burners Lane. CARC is separate from AGMK - it was incorporated as a CIC limited by guarantee in 2009 - but is closely associated with us.

AGMK operates as a company limited by guarantee with charitable status and was incorporated in May 2008 and registered with the Charity Commission at the same time.

Trustee Recruitment

We are looking to further increase the size of our Board, to bring additional skills, knowledge and connections and further innovation and fresh thinking to the team who have helped it prosper so far. Trustees provide the oversight and governance for the charity which includes a 70+ artists studio complex; part-time staff team; grants including from MK Community Foundation, MK Council, Arts Council England.

We are particularly looking for people who can help AGMK with specific skills and knowledge in:

- Programming or Producing in any artform
- Marketing and communications, including the use of digital media;
- IT
- Volunteer Management

We want the Board to have a wider representation of the diversity of our city. We are particularly interested in hearing from people of colour and individuals from the LGBTQIA+ community as well as professionals in the early stages of their careers. You do not need prior Trustee experience.

The Board holds monthly meetings and Trustees take part in task-and-finish working groups when specific issues arise that need more intensive consideration.
